


Regenerative System Thinking

SHORT DESCRIPTION

This method aims to bridge the understanding of environmental issues with the concrete actions needed to address them. Through an infographic, Bjørksov presents a six-step approach that combines the principles of systems thinking (planet) and human-centered design (people). This approach provides a framework for initiatives that take into account both human needs and ecological boundaries.



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SUGGESTIONS

This approach is particularly valuable for educators, trainers, and actors in the ecological transition. It aims to empower learners to act in a complex world by integrating knowledge, values, and practical skills.

How?

While following the model, learners could explore interconnections between natural, social, and economic systems. It could help them develop a holistic understanding of how these systems influence one another. It will also encourage them to design actions that benefit both the planet and its people, without sacrificing one for the other.
